



# Senior Design Program

## Fall 2011 / Spring 2012 Web Requirement

**Websites should be "up and running" by Wednesday, September 21<sup>st</sup>, 2011, noon.**  
**Web sites should be updated AT LEAST once a month, at the end of every calendar month.**

- There is no strict requirement about the look of the website, but consider making it nice and using it while applying for job positions.
- Keep in mind your final written report will be going to our Industrial Advisory Board for the Best Paper Contest and some of the judges might decide to visit your web-sites.
- Additionally, a lot of engineers from industry have had questions about the difficulty level of your projects and we invite them to visit Senior Design web-sites to get a feel of types and difficulty levels of our projects.
- At the same time, your project advisors might have additional requirements regarding details to be posted on-line as a way to communicate with you and supervise your work.
- Due to potential IP issues, *always* check with the advisor before posting information on the web
- Your project web site stays online after you leave!

So, try making it nice, but do not spend too much time on it. If you need assistance with designing and posting it, please let [olivera@colostate.edu](mailto:olivera@colostate.edu) know by **Wednesday, September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2011.**

### **The required links on your website are:**

- **Main page** (project title, team members, faculty advisor/industry advisor, collaboration with..., meeting time and venue). **File must be named [index.shtml](#)**
- **Project summary** (outline of project objective, scope, and tasks)
- **Timeline and deliverables** (it should reflect the planned timeline and deliverables, set at the beginning, as well as what has been done, updated periodically; by looking at this site/chart, one should be able to tell what you have planned and what delivered, and if you have delivered what promised)
- **Current status** (of the project; optional separate link; could be included as part of the timeline and deliverables link)
- **Team members** (list all students, undergraduate and graduate, and advisor; consider the link to the advisor's web site)
- **Budget**
- **Documents** (reports, E-Days poster, journal papers, conference papers and presentations, plans for 2nd semester, ideas for continuation of research, ...)
- **Acknowledgements** (thank you notes)

**On every page of your website, somewhere, you must also include the following elements:**

- “**Support our program**” button (graphics available in AY11 folder) to be linked to

- “**Other ECE Sr. Design projects**” linked to the project grid (graphics of your own choice)

### Directions for posting files:

The project folders will be posted by Wednesday, September 14<sup>th</sup> as:

**T:/projects/ece-sr-design/www/AY11/project-name**

Once formed, an excel spreadsheet with names of folders corresponding to projects will be e-mailed to all senior design students.

All students registered for ECE401 and ECE402 should have an access to these folders. Please check if you have been granted an access as there might be some flaws and **let Mrs. Notaros know by Wednesday, Sept 14<sup>th</sup> if you can not access**. If you haven't registered for the course you will not be allowed to access the folder!

Please, be considerate and visit **ONLY** your folder. Any unauthorized change of other project web sites will be treated as unethical and punished accordingly.

You may form your web site the way you like, with as many files as you wish/need.

**Your top level file should be called [index.shtml](#).**
