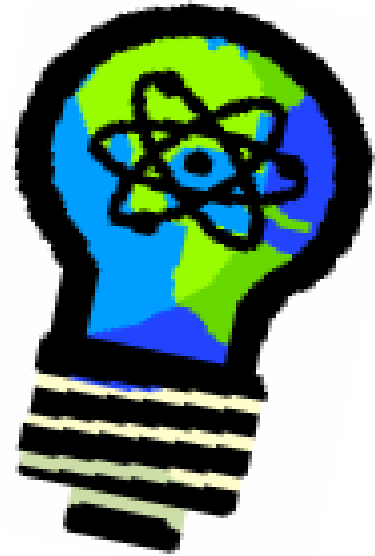


Want to Learn Simple Industrial Energy Efficiency Tips?
