

# Transfer Admission Requirements for the College of Engineering

---

**A. Transfers from ABET-EAC Accredited Programs**

Any students enrolled in an ABET accredited program will be admitted directly into the College of Engineering at Colorado State University provided the student is in good standing with a cumulative GPA  $\geq 2.5$ .

**B. All other Transfers\* into the College of Engineering must:**

1. Have a minimum cumulative GPA  $\geq 2.75$  from all previous college/university courses,  
AND
2. Have a grade of “B” or better in an approved course for each of the Subject Areas as specified in the chart below,  
AND
3. Have a “C” or better in the most recent course taken in each of the Subject Areas as specified in the chart below.

Courses must be taken at a regionally accredited college or university.

Students who were admitted to Colorado State University as first-time freshmen must complete the above requirements by the time they have earned 45 credits at Colorado State University. Those who were admitted as transfer students

must complete the above requirements by the time they have earned 30 credits at Colorado State University. **C. Second Bachelors**

Students seeking a second bachelor's degree will be accepted into engineering with a cumulative GPA  $\geq 2.75$  from all previous college-level course work.

**D. Freshmen in Non-Engineering Majors**

Freshmen students enrolled at Colorado State University can transfer into the College of Engineering during their first semester if they met the freshmen admission requirements for Engineering upon entering Colorado State University. Once their first semester has officially ended, these students are treated as transfer students following the criteria above.

**Change of Major Within the College of Engineering**

Students within the Colorado State University College of Engineering can freely transfer between majors in the college as long as they are in good academic standing: overall GPA  $\geq 2.0$  and math/science/engineering GPA  $\geq 2.0$ .
