The Rotary Foundation Volunteers program is administered through the World Headquarters of Rotary International and provides opportunities for Rotarians and other skilled professionals to offer their services and expertise to projects sponsored by their own Rotary club or district or to international projects requiring volunteers and expertise from abroad. This program strives to help those areas of the world that require assistance to raise their basic standard of living. Generally, the Volunteers assist in areas of health care, agricultural productivity, sanitation, disease eradication, commerce and technology. The Rotary Foundation Volunteers Program provides grant recipients with a round-trip ticket and partial subsidy to help cover expenses for their time of international service.

Alternatively, Rotary clubs and districts can use this Charity Miles Program to earmark specific mileage donations to provide free airfare for use in benefiting their own international humanitarian projects.
