

Visit Day Mini-Tour and Lunch on Saturday

We'll meet at 10:00 a.m. sharp on Saturday at the outdoor stairs between the Engineering Building and the Lory Student Center. We will leave by van, taking in parts of campus, along with **City Park**, an 85-acre park featuring Sheldon Lake. We will also travel by

- **Lory State Park**, 2,400 beautiful acres that provide hiking, picnicking, and camping with unique rock outcroppings, grassy meadows, and forests.
- **Horsetooth Reservoir**, 1,900 acres of water surrounded by 2,000 acres of public land, popular for fishing, boating, water-skiing, and camping. This 6.5-mile reservoir is open year round and is a part of the Colorado-Big Thompson Project operated by the Bureau of Reclamation and the Northern Colorado Water Conservancy District.
- **Old Town Fort Collins**, a well-preserved downtown district of 23 historical buildings that has a strong resemblance to Disneyland's Main Street USA because it was modeled after our own downtown Fort Collins! At last count there were 84 restaurants in Old Town.

We will end the tour with lunch at 11:30 am. Vans will return passengers to the CSU Transit Center or nearby hotel immediately following lunch.
