

Instructions for Installing VP-Sculpt:

1. **Download** the latest program from www.engr.colostate.edu/vpsculpt (see the bottom of the first main section of the website).
2. **Create a new folder** (directory) on your system (e.g., "VP-Sculpt " on the C: drive). If you are upgrading from a previous version, use the same folder as before.
3. **Copy "VPSculpt.exe"** (from the CD-ROM or e-mail attachment) into the new folder. If you are upgrading from a previous version, rename the original version first (e.g., "VPSculpt_previous") before copying the new file.
4. **Run VP-Sculpt** by double clicking on the *VPSculpt* application icon.
5. If you are running the program for the first time, VPSculpt will report your system serial number.
6. **Send the serial number** to your VPSculpt supplier and they will issue a key (also a number).
7. **Store the key** number in a file called "C:\VPSculpt.key" on your computer. The file can be created with Windows' *Notepad* (under "*Start – All Programs – Accessories*"). The file must be stored in the root of the C: drive (C:\), not in any folder (e.g., not in C:\VP-Sculpt\"). Be sure to save the file with a file type of "All Files" and not "Text Documents (.txt)" so a ".txt" extension doesn't get added to the end of the file name. The complete file name must be "VPSculpt.key" (not "VPSculpt.key.txt").
8. **Now VPSculpt will run.** These steps will not be required again for this computer.
