

Requirements and Selection Process of Teaching Assistants for the ECE Department

**Priority will be given to applicants who submit their materials by the required deadline.*

ECE Teaching Assistant (TA) Qualifications:

- Applicant must be enrolled as resident-instruction graduate student in the ECE Department for the semester for which they are applying to be a TA.
- Applicants must be in good academic standing by the start of the semester for which they are applying.
- Applicant must possess a strong understanding of the subject matter, including any required software tools, for the course for which they are applying to be a TA.
- Applicant must be willing to interact with and establish a good rapport with ECE students enrolled in the course for which they are applying to be a TA.
- If the applicant has served as a TA in previous semesters, they must have positive student evaluations to be considered for reappointment.
- Reappointments ARE NOT guaranteed. Existing TAs are required to re-apply every semester and be selected to continue.
- The ECE Department encourages applications from graduate students and undergraduates who are enrolled in upper division courses for the semester in which they are applying to be a TA.

Additional Details

- TAs are paid a monthly stipend for 4.5 months: \$2,000/mo. for PhD students and \$1,900/mo for Master's students.
- TAs typically work 20 hours per week.
- Tuition and fees may or may not be covered for the student. It will depend on what type of contract the TA is hired on.
