- Introductions & attendance

Introductions were made and a committee membership list was distributed. The list is attached; members from departments with unfilled positions are encouraged to fill them as soon as possible.

- Review Purpose of Committee & Charges for Technology

The scope of the committee is the administration and disbursement of the Engineering College student technology fund. In keeping with appropriate policies, the goal is to avoid departmental factions and view the technology charge fund as a college-wide resource.

This committee is not the College of Engineering Technology Committee (CETC), the committee that is charged with long-term oversight and planning of technology within the college. Membership consists of four representatives from the four departments on the main campus: two undergraduates, one graduate, and one faculty member. Members are appointed by the chair of each department.

The committee reports to the Dean of Engineering, but is governed primarily by the Charges for Technology Manual, a publication of the State Board of Agriculture. Pertinent items from the manual were noted and all members are encouraged to read the manual in its entirety, found on the web at: http://www.colostate.edu/services/acns/itec/fee.html.

University wide issues regarding the charge for technology are managed by the University Charges for Technology committee (CFT). The CFT also oversees changes and updates to the Charges for Technology Manual. Membership of the CFT consists of three representatives from each college, typically one member of the faculty/staff and two students.

- Discuss nominations for chair & election process

Two nominations were received for the committee chair: Eric Mui and David Wiegandt. Eric declined the nomination; David accepted and will serve as chair for this academic year.

- Expense review for 2000-2001

The final list of expenses against the student technology fund for the fiscal year 2001 was reviewed and discussed. The fiscal year for this fund is May 16 to May 15, following the academic year as opposed to the regular fiscal year.

- Budget review for 2001-2002

This year's budget was reviewed, with a detailed list of expenses to date distributed to the committee. It was noted that this information is public, but should be shared with discretion and a full explanation of the Charges for Technology process.
