RE: Lockheed Martin Design Studio improvements proposal

The ESTC has reviewed your proposal and approved the funding required to set up and maintain the two new classrooms in the Lockheed Martin Design Studio. The committee will provide ongoing funding for thin clients in each room and the one time funds necessary to equip and furnish the rooms. Specifically, the ESTC will provide ongoing funding (approximately \$68,000) for:

LMDS Classroom and Video Conference Room:

- 3 computers for video conferencing control station
- 33 thin clients (32 student seats, 1 lectern)
- 34 monitors (for 33 thin clients and 1 for video conferencing control station)
- 1 black and white laser printer
- 3 projectors
- 1 Smart Board

LMDS Small Classroom:

- 23 thin clients (22 student seats, 1 lectern)
- 23 monitors
- 1 black and white laser printer
- 1 projector
- 1 Smart Board

The ESTC will also provide one time funding of \$28,000 to help cover the cost of computer desks, chairs, and other furnishings that may be necessary. These funds are in addition to the \$6,000 already provided to match University Technology Fee funds and equip the room as a University Smart Classroom.
