- 3 computers for video conferencing control station
- 1 thin client for the lectern
- 2 monitors (1 for lectern and 1 for video conferencing control station)

Academic Village Collaborative Workrooms 2 & 3:

- 1 thin client per workroom
- 1 monitor per workroom
- 1 projector per workroom
- 1 Smart Board per workroom

Academic Village Reception Desk:

- 2 thin clients
- 2 monitors
