Matlab Update

Nick Stratton reported the Matlab university license finally got approved by all colleges and is now moving forward. Currently waiting for Natural Science's account numbers for the PO. Dec 1 is the target date for implementation but may be pushed back due to Natural Sciences. After the PO is issued, the process should be quick and easy.

Students will be able to download Matlab on their laptops through a custom portal, and we will have unlimited Matlab and associated Toolbox licenses (up to 50 toolboxes). Every single Toolbox that had five or more seats on it is covered. There were three Toolboxes within Engineering not covered but they had under five users each and these groups will need to pay only \$50 for a year of use.

Poster Cutter
