



All applicants must submit the following:

- Online Application**

- \$60 Application Fee**
 - This can be paid online when completing the online application.
- Professional Resume or Vita**
 - Upload directly to your application.
- Statement of Purpose**
 - The statement of purpose is typically 1-2 pages and briefly describes your background, educational goals, research interests, and why you would be a good fit in the program.
 - Additionally, in your statement of purpose, please address the following questions:
 - Why do you think you will succeed in this program?
 - How do you intend to be successful taking graduate level courses?
 - Upload directly to your application.
- Official transcript from each college or university you have attended**
 - Contact your previous institutions to request they submit official transcripts to Colorado State University (use institution code 4075).
 - Please note that a Bachelor's degree must be obtained by the applicant for admission.
- Program Course Prerequisites**
 - Calculus I Calculus II Calculus III Physics I Physics II
 - Ordinary Differential Equations Life Science Course
- Three Letters of Recommendation**
 - We recommend letters come from faculty, supervisors, etc. who can accurately speak to your skills as an engineer, scientist, researcher, student, etc.
 - Letters must be uploaded to your application or mailed to the Office of Admissions by the recommender. If your recommender chooses to mail the letter, they may send it to:
