

DAGNY HERBORG.

I, Dagny Herborg, was born in Twin Valley, Minnesota on August 1, 1898. I weighed twelve pounds when born and raised my head the first day. When I was eight years old my parents moved to Tolna, North Dakota and it was there that I finished grade school. In the Summer of 1913 we moved to Bremen, North Dakota. I attended high school there one year. In January 1916 I went to Park Region Luther College at Fergus Falls, Minnesota. In the Fall of 1916 I enrolled at the Bruflat Academy at Portland, North Dakota. I stayed there until I finished high school in June 1918. The first year I was at Bruflat Academy I lived with the C.A. Swensons, working for my board and room. The second year I stayed in the dormitory at Bruflat. While at Bruflat I made many good friends, among them Serena Winness, Anna Knutson and Inga Lien.

In April 1918 my parents moved to 622 10th Avenue North, Fargo, North Dakota. This was my home until I married. On September 13, 1918 I got my first position, as Assistant Bookkeeper for the Greenshields Electric and Plumbing Company in Fargo. In the Spring of 1920 I was made Head Bookkeeper and also Secretary and Treasurer. In the Fall of 1923 business was slack so I was laid off and stayed home all winter. In the Spring of 1924 I went to Chicago, Illinois to study at the Gregg Business School. In November I accepted a position with the Continental Credit Trust Company, of Chicago, as Assistant Auditor. When I went home for Christmas in 1924 the Greenshields Company had decided they needed me again and I was surely glad as there was no place like home and Fargo to me. I worked there until December 1926.

I had gone out with Sophus often while he was in school in Fargo. In January 1925 we started going steady. On May 25, 1925 he asked me to wear his Fraternity Pin, which I was very happy to do. He gave me my diamond for Christmas 1925. We were married December 29, 1926.
