

ERLING LEANDER.

Erling Leander, my oldest brother, was born in Twin Valley, Minnesota on November 20, 1891. He was a Sergeant in World War One. Enlisting as soon as war was declared in May 1917. On New Years Day 1918 he landed in France and did not get back to us until March 1919, altho the Armistice was signed on November 11, 1918. He came home as well as when he left. On September 8, 1923 he was married to Leah Fritz at the Episcopal Church at Devils Lake, North Dakota. They left the same day for Sioux Falls, South Dakota where they lived until the Spring of 1927.
